Board and Member meetings in review

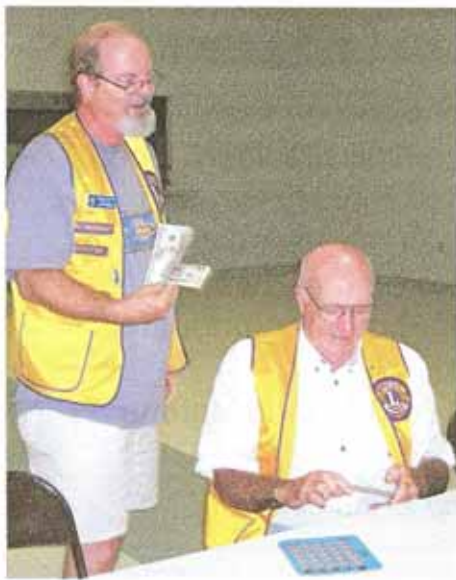
